Teachers are not authorized to sell their classes to students at Retreat. All classes are sold through NCCC class sales on sight. Everyone painting in the class has paid in advance of that class.

Teachers will not modify the initial classroom set – up with out first consulting the NCCC teacher coordinator or facilities Rep. If you know in advance of any special requirements you may have for your class, please indicate this on your teacher submission form.
